<p>Condition(s) of Employment: Prior to appointment in this position, selectee must Interstate Transfer to the DC National Guard (preferred) or provide TAG release memo authorizing extended performance in the District of Columbia in FTNGD-OS / ADOS status.</p>

<p>Description of Duties:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The District of Columbia National Guard is seeking highly qualified candidates to serve as the Joint Task Force Senior Enlisted Leader (JTF SEL) in support of the Make DC Safe and Beautiful mission. This is an O-6 command level position. 2. The SEL serves as the principal enlisted advisor to the Joint Task Force Commander and is responsible for ensuring the execution of the Commander's intent, maintaining standards and discipline, and synchronizing enlisted efforts across all assigned and attached forces. 3. The selected candidate will advise the Commander and senior leadership on all matters pertaining to enlisted readiness, utilization, morale, welfare, discipline, and professional development. The SEL will ensure unity of effort across Army and Air National Guard forces, while coordinating with interagency and Department of War partners operating within the National Capital Region. 4. Key responsibilities include establishing and maintaining an effective battle rhythm; overseeing enlisted personnel management and accountability; fostering a culture of professionalism, resilience, and teamwork; and mentoring subordinate senior enlisted leaders. The SEL will also represent the command at meetings, briefings, and conferences as required. 5. Ideal candidates possess prior experience serving as a senior enlisted advisor at the Brigade, Group, Wing, Division, or higher level, with demonstrated expertise in National Guard Civil Support and domestic operations. Candidates should exhibit strong leadership, communication, and organizational skills, along with a well-established professional network across the Joint Force and interagency partners. 6. This position requires the highest standards of integrity, professionalism, and the ability to operate effectively in a high-visibility and dynamic operational environment. 		

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Eligibility Requirements (Must meet all requirements prior to announcement close date):

1. Have completed all phases of Sergeant Major Academy and Chief Master Sergeant Leadership Course (or equivalent).
2. Be assigned to / transfer to the DCNG prior to appointment (preferred) or provide TAG release memorandum authorizing extended performance in the District of Columbia in a T32 FTNGD-OS / ADOS status.
3. Be in good standing - not under a Suspension of Favorable Actions "flagged" (Army) or Unfavorable Information File (UIF) (Air).
4. Meet the Army/Air Force medical retention standards in accordance with AR 40-501, Chapter 3, DAFMAN 48-123 and DoDI 6025.19. Applicants may not have temporary profiles.
5. Have a current passing fitness test and height / weight.
6. Have one (1) year of CSM/CMSgt experience at the O-6 Command Level.
7. Have a current security clearance, minimum of SECRET and be able to obtain a TOP SECRET.
8. Must meet all eligibility requirements prior to announcement close date.

Application Instructions: Applications missing required documents will be returned without consideration.

Required Documents:

1. Cover sheet with name, DODID number, email address, and phone number(s)
2. Last five evaluations
3. Current Fitness Test and Height / Weight (from ATIS for Army and myFitness for Air)
4. Army – Soldier Talent Profile (STP) from IPPS-A (dated within 60 days)
5. Air – Report of Individual Personnel (RIP) from vMPF (dated within 60 days)
6. If not reflected / current on STP or RIP, security clearance verification memorandum reflecting at least a Secret clearance (*within 90 days*)
7. Applicant memo stating intent to transfer to the DCNG or, if requesting to remain assigned to current state, TAG release memorandum authorizing long-term T32 FTNGD-OS / ADOS status
8. Applicant memorandum addressing any discrepancies / deficiencies in their personnel record

Optional Documents:

1. Certificate of Training that is not already listed on training record
2. Special skill certification or license that is pertinent to the position
3. Recommendation letter(s) from current or previous employers or commanders

It is the applicant's responsibility to contact the announcement POC prior to the vacancy closing date to verify all documents have been received. Failure to do so may result in disqualification. Complete and accurate information is essential to ensure a fair evaluation of candidates.
