- 3.) Must meet the Army medical retention standards in accordance with AR 40-501, Chapter 3, and as outlined below.
The Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) Report must be current and reflect:
 - A current Physical Health Assessment (PHA) and no Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) deficiencies.
 - The Soldier must be fit for retention in his/her AOC
- 4.) 31A required, Military Police Captain's Career Course Phase 1 required
- 5.) Must meet all eligibility requirements prior to announcement close date.
- 6.) Must be willing to execute long periods of ADOS IAW EO14339 to support the enhanced 372d Military Police Battalion

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Company Commander responsible for the training, discipline, welfare, retention, and morale of assigned Soldiers. Ensures the company meets readiness and training standards for required missions, to include new state training guidance implementation in current fiscal year in support of the state, brigade, and battalion. Integrates the risk management process in all training to mitigate potential risk and promote safety in how the unit functions. Responsible for the command supply discipline program, the command maintenance discipline program, and the command deployment discipline program. Establishes a command climate to promote effective communication, cohesiveness, teamwork, and retention for a strong effective unit. Fosters a climate of Soldier care and Family support.
