- 3.) Current Enlisted Record Brief (certified board version). Nominees are responsible for ensuring all data reflected in the ERB is current.
- 4.) DTMS printout of Record ACFT. Ensure your name is visible on the printout.
- 5.) DTMS printout of Height/Weight. Ensure your name is visible on the printout.
- 6.) Most recent DA Form 1059 indicating highest military education completed.
- 7.) Copy of last five NCOERs.
- 8.) MEDPROS printout with the date of current PHA and PULHES included (within 12 months).
- 9.) Copy of Medically Signed/Completed Medical Profile (if applicable).
- 10.) Letter of recommendation from chain of command. (optional)
- 11.) A Security Verification Memorandum with at least a Secret Clearance level (*within 90 days of closing date*).
- 12.) Biographical Sketch IAW NGR 600-200, Figure G-3.
- \*All documents must be consolidated into a single pdf file. DO NOT put it in PDF Portfolio format.

Position Title: 74th Troop Command Brigade Command Sergeant Major (M-Day)

## **Brief Description of Duties:**

Serves as the Senior Enlisted Advisor to the Brigade Commander for the 74<sup>th</sup> Troop Command; responsible for the development of tactics, techniques, and procedures that focus on the shaping and sustainment of the force and mission; sets the standards and is the principle enforcer of policies, regulations, and directives; accomplishes the mission through developing subordinates in becoming independent of supervision; serves as the primary enlisted advisor on all Soldier, morale, welfare, and technical and tactical issues; provides strategic input regarding current and future operations in addition to enforcing consistent transformation.

#### Qualifications:

- 1.) Must have a minimum-security clearance of SECRET and be able to obtain a TOP SECRET.
- 2.) All applicants are subject to a state background check prior to selection.
- 3.) Have previous First Sergeant experience (preferred).

## **Eligibility Requirements:**

- 1.) Must have completed ALL phases of the United States Army Sergeants Major Academy.
- 2.) Current CSM or appear on an HQDA (ARNG) CSM Selection Board results list.
- 3.) The Soldier must have a current passing ACFT.
- 4.) The Soldier must have a current passing DA 5500/5501 (if applicable).
- 5.) The Soldier must be assigned to the DCARNG, be in good standing, and must not be under a suspension of favorable actions per Army Regulation 600-8-2, Suspension of Favorable Personnel Actions (Flag), dated 5 April 2021.
- 6.) The Soldier must meet the Army medical retention standards in accordance with Army Regulation 40-501, Chapter 3, and as outlined below. The MEDPROS Individual Medical Readiness Report (IMR) must be current and reflect:
  - A current (12 mo.) Physical Health Assessment (PHA) and no Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) deficiencies.
  - A current HIV test. All Soldiers must have a current negative HIV-1 test within 2 years of the projected report date.
  - The Soldier must be fit for retention in his/her Primary MOS.
