MEMORANDUM FOR DCNG-ALL

SUBJECT: District of Columbia National Guard Environmental Policy Statement

1. The District of Columbia National Guard work force and all tenants of our facilities must be committed to environmental stewardship. These facilities include the DCNG Armory; Joint Base Anacostia Bolling, including CSMS, FMS 1, FMS 2, FMS 3, USPFO, and Readiness Center; Fort Belvoir, including the RTI and Army Aviation buildings, Youth Challenge Academy at Oak Hill and the Oak Hill Training Facility, in Laurel, Maryland; as well as the recruiting office located at Northwest, Washington, DC.
2. The DCNG will continually assess and update the Environmental Management System to ensure its continual improvement. Through sound environmental management, the DCNG is resolutely committed to:
  - a. Identifying and addressing pollution prevention opportunities and reduction strategies in order to meet or exceed Army goals for prevention of pollution.
  - b. Considering the environmental impacts of all agency action in all planning processes relative to training, equipment fielding, real estate transfers, and construction.
  - c. Maintaining compliance with all applicable Federal, District, and local environmental laws.
3. This policy is available on the DCNG GKO Environmental website. Supervisors will ensure that a copy of the policy is posted in each Directorate, unit office, or work area. This policy is available to the public upon request, through the Public Affairs Office.
