Dear Judge Detamore,

The purpose of this letter is to notify you that Private XXXXXXXXXX is on active duty in the Army National Guard. He is currently at Fort Sill Oklahoma for 16 weeks of Basic Training and Advanced Individual Training under 10 USC 672 (d). I have enclosed a copy of the military order placing him on active military duty (Encl. 1). This military order makes it impossible for this soldier to conduct his defense or otherwise to participate in the above entitled legal action currently underway in your court. I have also enclosed a letter from the unit commander explaining why the soldier's current military duty prevents his ability to appear in court and stating that military leave is not presently authorized for the soldier at this time.

Under 50 U.S.C. App. 522, 108 P.L. 189, Section 202, such a proceeding <u>shall</u> be stayed upon an application for stay being made by the soldier or someone on his behalf, unless in the opinion of the Court, the ability of the defendant to conduct his defense is not materially affected by reason of his military service.

Please enter an order of stay for the period of military duty plus 30 days and provide a copy to my office so that I may forward a copy to the soldier. Thank you for your help.
